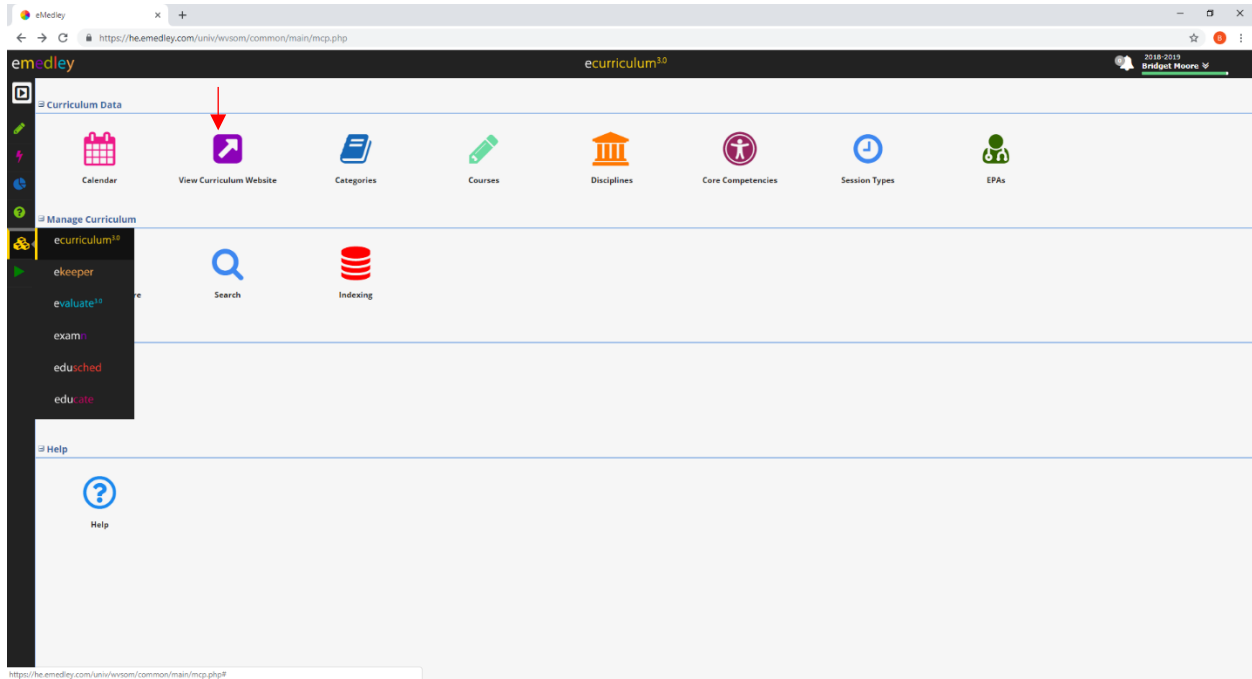
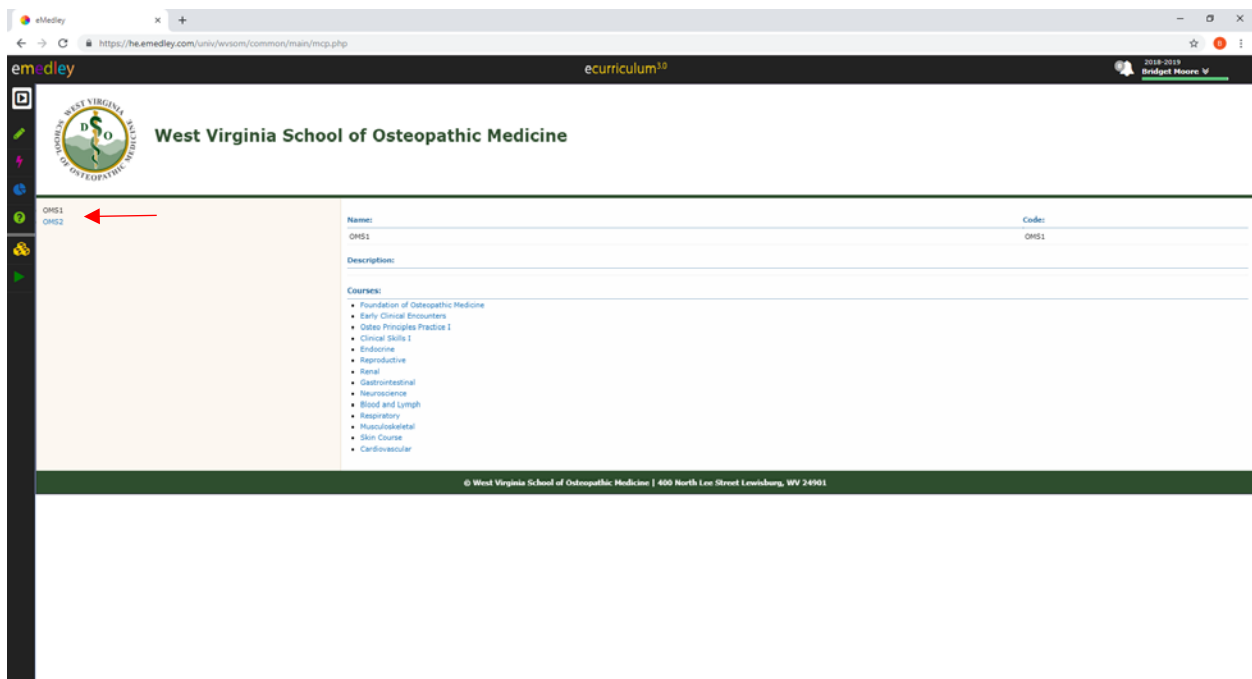


# Viewing Course Syllabi
